What is PII?

Protected information (PII) is information in any form, including a combination of any of the following information:

- first names
- last names
- account number
- social security numbers
- credit card numbers
- dates of birth
- financial account numbers
- driver's license numbers
- ID numbers
- medical information
- email addresses
- mailing addresses

Are forms on the internet secure?

Forms on the internet are generally not secure. Although you may connect to a form with SSL as indicated by the HTTPS and/or lock, that does not mean the form is compliant. To be compliant, the data must be *encrypted at rest* on the server where it is stored.

Can PII be emailed?

PII data cannot be emailed. Only a notice that the form has been used can be emailed and then the form owner must log in to access the encrypted data securely.
